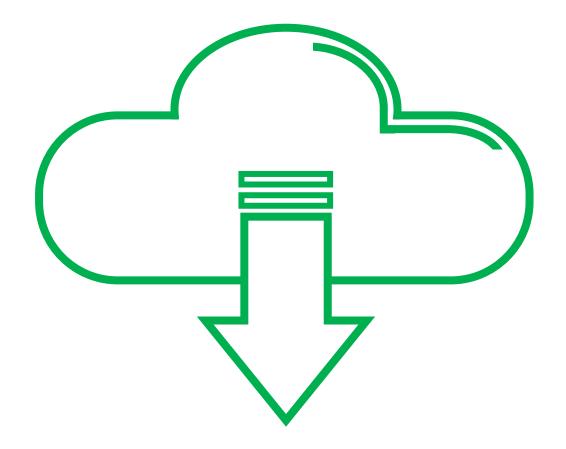

Split the Thinkit into manageable chunks.

Choose a chunk at a time to memorise.

Start with the most important or the most difficult.

Re-read your notes on the chosen topic.

Do some wider research on the internet until you understand it.

Use Thinkit/Graspit/ Knowit independence Apps etc. Write a detailed description or an explanation about everything you know about this topic. Try to do this without your notes. Topic on a page. Write key facts you need to memorise over and over until you have memorised them.

Give a verbal explanation about this topic as if you were teaching it.

Repeat facts you need to remember 20 times.

Record key facts about this topic onto your phone.

Say what you've learnt from memory, using the Thinkit images to prompt you.
